Scholarship Guidelines and Eligibility Criteria

- The student must have at least a 75% average (Christian Ethics 30, English A and B 30, Social Studies 30, highest marks in any three 30 level subjects – then divide by 7).
- The recipient should exhibit strong leadership and sportsmanship qualities as well as being a
 positive role model in his/her school and/or community.
- Have been involved in at least two Vanier Sports programs throughout his/her years.
- Have taken at least one credit Physical Education class (20 or 30)
- Financial need
- Enrolled at Vanier for at minimum of two years.

Selection: Preference may be given to a student who will continue to participate in sports at the post-secondary or amateur level, as a player, official or coach.

Deadline: Applications must include all of the following documents:
