



G3 Grow Beyond Scholarship to drive innovation in agriculture

Winnipeg – October 29, 2019 – G3, in partnership with Agriculture in the Classroom Canada, is proud to present an exciting new scholarship opportunity.

The G3 Grow Beyond Scholarship will be presented for the first time in 2020, to six high school students who are embarking on a post-secondary education and have innovative ideas for agriculture in Canada.

Six scholarships of \$4,000 are available to students across Canada* looking to study in any discipline, and an additional \$1,000 will be given to the winners' high schools. In order to apply, students must submit a two- to four-minute video essay describing their vision for the future of agriculture in Canada and how they see themselves contributing to that vision.
