


## Guidelines to Principal/Guidance Counsellor:

- 1) Two scholarships of \$500 dollars each to be awarded to two (2) applicants continuing on to <u>any</u> post-secondary educational institute.
- 2) The Friendly City Optimist Club require that applicants have involvement in Community, School, Youth and/or other volunteer activities as well as some leadership qualities
- 3) Applicants shall be registered in Grade 12, in Moose Jaw and attending Riverview Collegiate, Vanier Collegiate, Central Collegiate, Peacock Collegiate or Cornerstone Christian School, be eligible to graduate and require a minimum grade average of 75%.
- 4) Applications to be given to the Friendly City Optimist Club Committee Chair by the <u>Deadline date</u> of May 20<sup>th</sup> each year.
- 5) A copy of the Applicant's transcript to be supplied by the Principal and/or Guidance Counsellor.
- 6) Only the successful applicants and their respective School will be notified.

- 4) Applicants should be involved with community, youth, school, and/or other volunteer activities.
- Applicants will be considered on the basis of a good academic standing, citizenship and leadership qualities.
- 6) A copy of the Applicant's transcript is required from the Principal or Guidance Counsellor.
- 7) Applications must be submitted to the scholarship committee Chair by <u>Deadline</u> <u>date</u> of May 20<sup>th</sup> each year.
