Redemptorist Fathers Scholarship

St. Joseph Parish Council has initiated an annual scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 to commemorate the 75th Anniversary of the Redemptorist Fathers in Moose Jaw. This scholarship will be awarded to a Catholic student from Vanier Collegiate in his/her first year of post-secondary education, who meets the following criteria:

Eligibility:

- 1. The applicant must be accepted and registered at a recognized post-secondary educational institution for his/her first year of post-secondary education, within two years of their Grade 12 graduation.
- 2. The application must be received no later than May 15 May 1st.

Selection Committee and Selection Criteria:

- 1. The selection committee will consist of at least (3) representatives from St. Joseph Parish Council and a representative from Vanier Collegiate, not related to any of the applicants.
- 2. The selection committee will consider the following:
 - i. Academic standing (10 points)
 - ii. Participation in extra-curricular school activities (25 points)
 - iii. Community involvement and activities (25 points)
 - iv. Church involvement (30 points)
 - v. Financial need (10 points)
- 3. Decisions made by the selection committee will be confidential and are final.
- 4. The scholarship committee will make their decision by Commencement (end of June).

Applicants must submit:

- 1. A completed Application Form (attached).
- 2. A copy of Grade 12 Transcript of Marks from the Vanier Office.
- 3. A letter of reference from the Principal, Vice-Principal or a teacher from Vanier.
- 4. A letter of reference from a parish priest/minister outlining involvement.
- 5. A copy of the acceptance letter from the post-secondary institution.

To be eligible for the Redemptorist Father Scholarship, you must:

- Be accepted and registered at a recognized post-secondary educational institution for first year of postsecondary education, within two years of Grade 12 graduation.
- Remain in a post-secondary educational institution for a one-year period on a full-time basis.
- Illustrate some involvement in any or all the following areas: extracurricular school activities, community leadership and church involvement.
