Scholarship amount: \$1,000.00

One scholarship annually..

Eligibility: scholarship will be awarded to one Grade Twelve Student graduating from a

Moose Jaw high school:

Central Collegiate Institute; Peacock Collegiate; Riverview Collegiate; Vanier Collegiate; Cornerstone Christian School.

Criteria:

1. **Academic standing:** student should be in the top 10% of the class.
June final marks recorded on school letterhead paper signed by Principal or Guidance Counsellor of respective high school.
2. **Involvement** in school extra-curricular activities.
3. **Leadership** : school (SLC/SRC, clubs ...)
Extra-curricular outside school (youth groups, choirs ...)
Rotary Youth Leadership Assembly
Work related leadership (supervisor...)
4. **Volunteer** work in school and community: where? Length of time?
5. Work experience: where? Length of time?

Essay (500 words): Essay is written by applicant explaining why he/she should be considered for the scholarship

Two references: teacher
non-family member (ie. Employer, minister: **not another teacher**).

Application deadline: **Postmarked no later than June 30th of applicable year.**

Award date: September of applicable year.

Scholarship will be paid directly to the Registrar of the student's post-secondary institution. An official acceptance letter/acknowledgement at the post-secondary institution must be mailed to Wakamow Rotary Club Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship may be deferred for a year if the student is a year long Rotary Exchange Student or is deferring post-secondary attendance to work due to financial need.
