Application deadline: Postmarked no later than June 30<sup>th</sup> of applicable year.

Award date: September of applicable year.

Scholarship will be paid directly to the Registrar of the student's post-secondary institution. An official acceptance letter/acknowledgement at the post-secondary institution must be mailed to Wakamow Rotary Club Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship may be deferred for a year if the student is a year long Rotary Exchange Student or is deferring post-secondary attendance to work due to financial need.
